



## Leading Restaurant Brand Migrates Off StorSimple into Nasuni®

Maintaining that timeless appeal requires constant innovation, and the IT leadership at TGI Fridays recognized the benefits of cloud file storage earlier than many leading enterprises.

Initially, the company moved its file data to the cloud through a StorSimple gateway device. When TGI Fridays IT learned this device would no longer be supported, they launched a rigorous evaluation of their alternatives. In their search, Infrastructure Team Lead Michael Oehlert and Systems Administrator Victor Martinez of TGI Fridays came across Nasuni. The technical architecture of the Nasuni File Data Platform immediately appealed to the pair, and the fact that several of its industry competitors were already relying on Nasuni was an important validation. Soon, TGI Fridays made the decision to migrate its file data from StorSimple to Nasuni.

### Nasuni File Data Platform

Before initiating the migration, TGI Fridays worked with Nasuni's Professional Services team to ensure an optimal cutover. "When you move a large volume of data, it matters who owns what and who has specific rights," explains Oehlert. "There was data that as an administrator I couldn't even move."

This early legwork paid off, as no one within TGI Fridays even noticed the cutover, including the heavy users. "I actually got an award," Oehlert says, "because everyone was convinced it was going to be a nightmare, and no one even knew it happened. My bosses were asking when it was going to happen, and I replied, 'We already did it. The job's done.'"

Now that TGI Fridays has upgraded to the Nasuni File Data Platform backed by Azure Blob storage, the company enjoys numerous short- and long-term benefits.

## Unlimited, On-demand Storage

The first is scale. Thanks to Nasuni, TGI Fridays file data can expand its cloud storage footprint on-demand, in an incremental fashion, growing in line with its needs.

## 20% Azure Cost Reduction

TGI Fridays projects to save 20% in Azure storage costs by moving to Nasuni. The StorSimple device had large amounts of data reserved, which drove up total storage in Azure. Nasuni reduces this overall capacity thanks in part to compression and deduplication, leading to the 20% reduction in cloud costs.

## Fast Local File Access

Although file data scales in the cloud, Nasuni caches frequently accessed files at the edge for fast performance, ensuring that users can work at local speeds. “We were concerned about performance initially, but we have had no complaints at all,” Oehlert adds. “As far as I’ve heard from our users, it’s the same story as the migration. No one noticed a difference.”

## Rapid Ransomware Recovery

TGI Fridays is a very security conscious organization, according to Oehlert. Yet, as he points out, all it takes is one person making one little mistake for malware to slip past even the best defenses. Nasuni gives the company unparalleled protection and peace of mind. “The number one advantage of the Nasuni platform for me was the ransomware recovery,” Oehlert says. “The Nasuni approach is very efficient. We can go into the file directories, step back in time and recover individual files or entire volumes. I can recover from a ransomware event in a matter of hours, or probably less.”

## Powerful Management

Martinez cites the Nasuni Management Console (NMC) as another strength of the platform, as it gives IT more control and visibility. “I appreciated how we could monitor the synchronization during the migration,” Martinez notes. “A lot of times, with other solutions, you pull a switch and then pray and wait. With the NMC, we were able to watch the files move across and know that everything was happening as it was supposed to happen.”
