AEC firm bolsters ransomware protection & cyberinsurance with Nasuni

Founded by architects and engineers in 1988, Highland Associates has designed everything from residential properties to missioncritical facilities, including cloud data centers. This deep familiarity with the cloud is one of the many reasons the firm's IT department initiated a shift away from traditional file storage infrastructure.

The VPN connection between Highland Associates' main locations was horrible, according to Director of IT Bruce Sobocinski, Sr. "Syncing Revit models would take way too long, and if anybody wanted to do any renderings, it was just brutal," he recalls. Highland Associates had begun using the Autodesk Construction Cloud, but this wasn't fast enough for internal revisions. Sobocinski was wary of his next storage refresh, given the increasing cost of hardware, and the threat of ransomware had turned cybersecurity into an executive-level concern.

Then a new hire told them about Nasuni — the hybrid cloud platform his previous architecture firm had relied on. Sobocinski was sold on Nasuni's scalability, flexibility, cost structure, multi-site collaboration capabilities, and ransomware protection package.

Ransomware protection

The Nasuni File Data Platform automates data protection through continuous file versioning to the cloud. Highland Associates chose to further strengthen its security with Nasuni's Ransomware Protection Service, which proactively detects, alerts, quarantines, and reports on incidents.

Cyberinsurance ROI

One of the unexpected benefits? Cyberinsurance is essential for some of its customers, but prior to Nasuni, few carriers would offer the firm a policy. Once Highland Associates strengthened its position through Nasuni and other solutions, the firm received bids from 4X as many carriers. Highland Associates was able to choose a policy 2X as large for roughly the same price, and from a better provider.

"We have a more robust carrier and better coverage, so the ransomware investment paid for itself," Sobocinski explains. "Cyberinsurance is like car insurance. It's not if you're going to use it, but when, and you better have a good policy."

Sleeping soundly

For Sobocinski, Nasuni's ransomware protection has additional advantages. "Honestly, my sleep has gotten a lot better since moving to Nasuni, now that I'm not worrying about failed backups or ransomware," he says.

Highland Associates was drawn to the flexibility of the Nasuni File Data Platform, and the ability to opt for multiple clouds. The data center design business at Highland Associates has been expanding rapidly in recent years. Shrinking infrastructure

Highland Associates only needs to cache around 5% of its total storage on local appliances to provide the rendering performance and flexibility the firm's architects and designers need. "Our next server refresh is coming up, and I'm excited because our footprint should be shrinking a lot because we're pushing so much data out [the cloud]," adds Sobocinski.

Data intelligence & beyond

The IT team at Highland Associates has been experimenting with Nasuni IQ to capture insights into the firm's data growth vectors and user behaviors relating to file revisions and overwriting.

"Our board had really been after us to capitalize on all this new technology and install a robust system," says Sobocinki. "Nasuni checks all the boxes. It made our bosses happy."
