This was no small task as Martians regularly generate everything from 4K videos to high-resolution 3D displays. The need to support his colleagues and drastically improve data protection prompted Hittleman and his team to begin evaluating new ways to store, share, and protect files. After rigorously testing several solutions, the agency turned to Nasuni.

Nasuni Cloud File Storage

As the first and only cloud-native file storage, Nasuni met The Mars Agency's industry-leading technology and security standards. The Nasuni platform's proven success with two of the top advertising agencies in the world reassured Hittleman, and since modernizing its infrastructure with Nasuni, the agency has enjoyed multiple advantages.

Unlimited Cloud Capacity

Nasuni extends the unlimited scale of cloud file storage to every location while caching copies of frequently used files locally on lightweight Edge Appliance virtual machines. This way, Martians everywhere—including those working from home—have fast, secure access to files without needing duplicate storage arrays in each location.

Conserving Cash

Prior to selecting Nasuni, The Mars Agency had a much more capital-intensive infrastructure. "In the old days, we'd go and spend millions of dollars on a hardware refresh and we'd be stuck with that for years, even if we were only using a small percentage of it," explains Hittleman. "Moving to an operating expense mode with Nasuni has helped us even out our cash flow."

Optimizing Spending & Productivity

Nasuni's fast file synchronization and rapid recoveries dovetail with the agency's value-focused business model. "In our business, time is money. Our clients pay us for our time and we commit to being efficient with those dollars," Hittleman explains. "Having somebody wait for an upload to send to a colleague on the other side of the pond in London does not support our business model, and Nasuni helped solve that problem."

More Efficient Collaboration

At The Mars Agency, a new product launch or ongoing campaign involves different people in different places. Prior to Nasuni, a designer in New York and a creative in Detroit might unknowingly work on the same file at the same time, leading to productivity-killing version conflicts. Nasuni is designed to facilitate fast, secure, conflict-free collaboration. And that, in turn, means the agency's clients are getting the most for their dollar.

Vastly Improved RTOs

Previously, The Mars Agency set a goal of reducing its recovery point and recovery time objectives (RPOs and RTOs) to one hour, and they achieved that with Nasuni. "Our files are huge," says Senior Network Engineer Phil Mulloy. "How do you create a disaster recovery plan for hundreds of terabytes that will get all those files back in an hour? That's impossible unless you've got a solution like Nasuni."

Incremental RPOs

In the past, it might have taken hours or even days to restore a lost file, and even then IT might have to roll back to a previous version that was a day or two old. "Losing a day's worth of work is a big deal. I mean, that could have been the entire project," adds Hittleman. "We had to find a way to get our RTOs and RPOs down, and Nasuni is able to bring us back to a point in time within seconds, which is remarkable."

The Mars Agency has several satellite offices near the headquarters of major retailers like Kroger, Walmart, and Target, to facilitate strong relationships and provide in-market expertise for clients at the customer level. “Nasuni makes it very easy for us to not only open or expand an office, but to house a creative team in those offices, and that’s a big difference,” explains Hittleman. “Historically, it was very difficult for us to stand up a new office in a reasonable amount of time because of the infrastructure that was required, but now with the ability to just put a small piece of hardware there and a Nasuni virtual appliance, it’s pretty painless.”

Freeing IT for Strategic Work

Since Nasuni automates and simplifies so many mundane tasks, IT has more time to focus on strategic projects like the agency’s MarilynSM marketing technology platform, which helps the firm’s clients deliver stronger results with their marketing investments.

Looking Ahead

Hittleman sees his agency’s relationship with Nasuni as a long-term infrastructure solution. The Mars Agency is already using artificial intelligence and machine learning to scour its file data for strategic insights, and Hittleman is looking forward to leveraging Nasuni’s Analytics Connector to make running analytics even easier. As the agency looks ahead at a post-pandemic business world, Hittleman is also glad to have a more flexible file infra-

structure with Nasuni. “We’re thinking about what the implications are to the current infrastructure and how we support a longer-term work from home environment,” he notes. “I think Nasuni and The Mars Agency are going to be well-positioned to deal with that on a long-term basis.”

More generally, the pandemic has strengthened the agency’s resolve to work with the

best technology providers, both to support its own users and to show its clients that The Mars Agency is doing everything possible to deliver results. “Our clients are thankful for a lot of
